

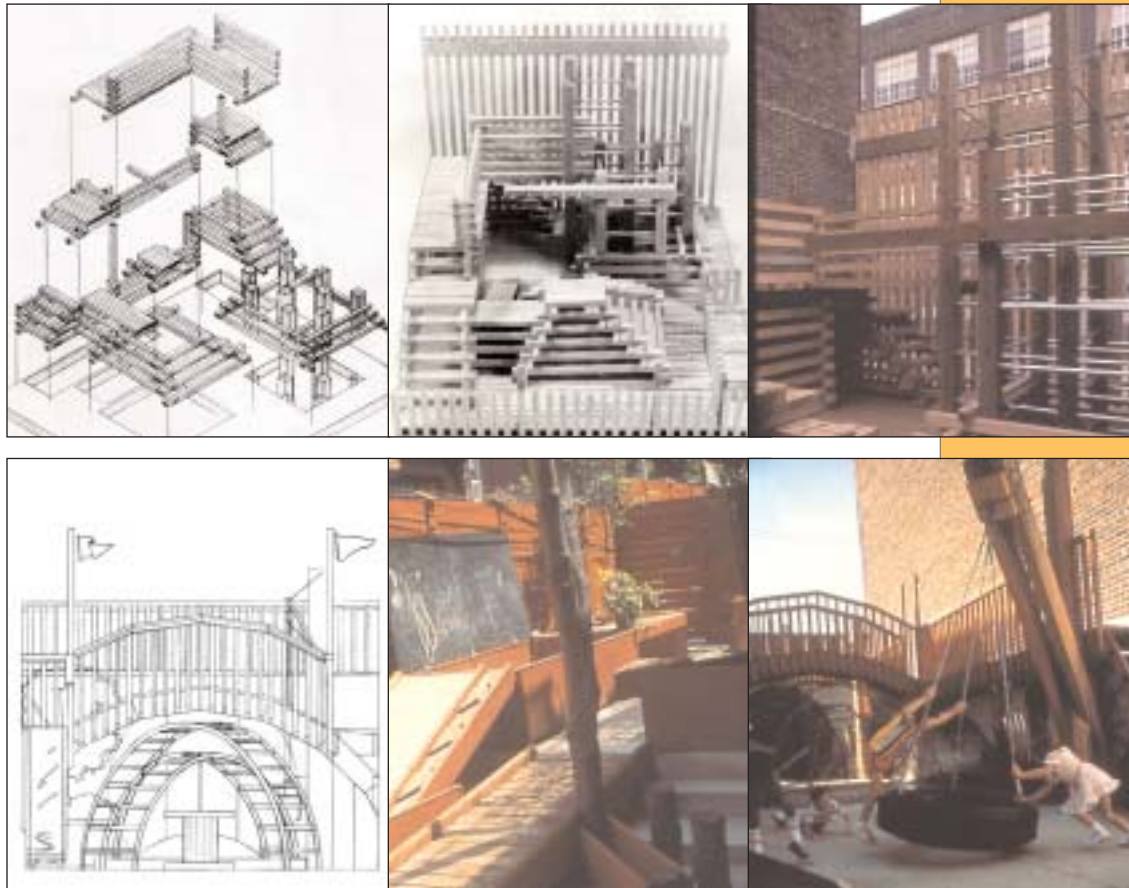
Playgrounds...

Project: Hope Day & Jackson Street Playgrounds

The challenge was to pack in as much fun as these limited, urban spaces could hold and do it on a tight budget. This was accomplished by designing elements that could be fabricated by local labor with no exotic materials or technologies. The playgrounds were built by a two man crew. The combination of local labor and traditional building techniques realized significant savings. Detailed, step-by-step drawings were supplied and close communication with the crew was essential.

The end result is play environments that offer a rich continual play experience. At any point there are choices for a young person to make and enjoy. There is a variety of options for gross and fine motor play. Safety was a prime concern and the highest standards of the day were applied to every aspect of these projects.

Both sites offer a genuine sense of surprise when first discovered.
